Canine Vision Dog Guides



assist Canadians (12 years+) who are blind or visually impaired. These Dog Guides are trained to navigate obstacles typically found on daily routes, including curbs, steps, and crowds. With a Dog Guide to help them travel freely and safely, handlers feel self-assured every time they leave home.

Service Dog Guides



help Canadians (10 years+) who have a physical or medical disabilities. These Dog Guides aid handlers in retrieving objects. opening/closing doors and appliances, and are trained to bark or activate an alert system when help is needed.

Autism Assistance Dog Guides



help families with children (ages 3-12) on the autism spectrum. These Dog Guides provide safety, companionship and unconditional love. They offer a calming relief for children in high anxiety situations and reduce the stress commonly experienced in public places.

Hearing Ear Dog Guides



assist individuals (10 years+) who are deaf or hard of hearing, and are unable to detect everyday important sounds. These Dog Guides have been taught to distinguish sounds (doorbell, alarm clock, fire alarm, ringing phone, etc.), make physical contact with their handlers, and then signal which sound is occurring.

Seizure Response Dog Guides



are trained to help people (6 years+) with epilepsy. These Dog Guides are capable of activating an alert system or barking for help in the event of a seizure. Their ability to both respond and react quickly provides their handlers with confidence to live independently.

Diabetic Alert Dog Guides



assist people (10 years+) who have type 1 diabetes with hypoglycemic unawareness. They are trained to detect sudden drops in their handler's blood sugar through scent, alert them so they can ingest something sweet, and avoid a hypoglycemic episode which can lead to lifethreatening effects. These Dog Guides are also able to get help or activate an alert system if needed.



Lions Foundation of Canada Dog Guides' mission is to assist Canadians with a medical or physical disability by providing them Dog Guides at no cost.
